Elemental balance of Nature includes Air, Water, Earth, Fire My understanding is that these ashes are from Sacred ceremonial fires held some 10,000 years ago. Women tended the fires which provided warmth, fuel for preparing food and ceremony circles. We know there is evidence of intentional/useful fire 2 million years ago, so it is believable that these ashes were saved and passed down over the years.

For our gatherings, GrandMother Chrystal (Donna) Johnson kept the ashes for 20+ years fallowed by GrandMother Terry Bourne for about 10 yrs and me for about 10 years now. I understand we all received them at a Give Away ceremony at a gathering unaware that we were getting them. I feel it is an honor.

A smudge from the ashes is offered at our gatherings to remember and honor the GrandMothers who have gone before us. And to acknowledge they are with us/blessing us during our gathering.

Throat - Vocalization
Heart - Love
Feet - Dance/Movement

We rest gently on the backs of the generations of GrandMothers who have gone before us and prepare our backs to hold those going before us.
